Sustainability awards

Müller Plastics has received the Gold Medal from Ecovadis for outstanding performance in environmental, social and corporate governance, placing it in the top 5% of companies assessed.

Climate-neutral Müller Group

Müller Plastics' contribution to a climate-neutral Müller Group: The new regrind dust extraction systems optimize the production process and reduce energy consumption.



Resource-saving products

- The new regrind extraction systems reduce the dust content, allowing more regrind to be used and thus increasing raw material efficiency.
- A new emulsion splitting system enables the fully automatic separation of oil and water mixtures.
- The product range has been expanded to include the ReCan, a container made from qualified recycled material from the Müller Group. This saves resources.



Self-motivated employees

- In a series of workshops, senior managers developed communication principles.
- Team spirit was fostered and promoted at a summer barbecue and a Christmas dinner.
- A survey was conducted among employees to find out their communication needs and opportunities to help shape sustainability.
